



Payson City Rec Phase In Plan



The health and safety of our community is Payson City Recreations top priority.

The following strategies and policies are designed to guide the re-opening and operation of Payson City Recreation Programs and pool in accordance with the Governor's Phased Guidelines for the General Public and Businesses to Maximize Public Health and Economic Reactivation under the "Moderate Risk" Range. Guidelines, where appropriate, were selected from Governor Herbert's Utah Leads Together 4.0 .

Where conflicting, overlapping or ambiguous guidelines exist, the department director and elected city officials will work to establish best-practices for each area that prioritize staff and public health and safety. Subject to change if circumstances or directives dictate.

High Risk

- Maximum number of patrons must be such that a 6- foot distance between patrons and employees can be easily maintained (1 person per 100 square feet)
- Provide hand sanitizer at checkout counters and entrance/exit
- Do not engage in close-contact or team sports
- Do not travel to, or participate in activities at, any of the following locations: places of public amusement or public activity. public swimming pools. Gyms, and fitness centers.

Moderate Risk

- Maximum number of patrons must be such that a 6- foot distance between patrons and employees can be easily maintained (1 person per 100 square feet)
- Regularly disinfect high-touch areas (e.g. door handles, buttons/switches, handrails, shopping carts, check-out counters, restroom surfaces)
- Provide hand sanitizer at entrance/exit
- Interactions in decreased group sizes that enable all social distancing guidelines to be maintained; social interactions in groups of 20 or fewer
- Do not arrange or participate in in-person playdates or similar activities
- Do not engage in close-contact or team sports • Pools operate at 50% capacity, one swimmer per lane, no congregating on pool decks

Low Risk

- Resume to normal patron capacity
- Regularly disinfect high-touch areas (e.g. door handles, buttons/switches, handrails, shopping carts, check-out counters, restroom surfaces)
- Provide hand sanitizer at checkout counters and entrance/exit
- Staff only come closer than 6 feet when accepting payment or delivering goods or services if wearing a face covering
- Interactions in decreased group sizes that enable all social distancing guidelines to be maintained; social interactions in groups 50 or fewer
- Exhibit caution when engaging in close-contact or team sports, including symptom checking of participants
- Pools operate at 50% capacity, one swimmer per lane, no congregating on pool decks

Normal

- Interactions allowable in larger groups, with strict hygiene measures and symptom monitoring
- Regularly disinfect high-touch areas (e.g. door handles, buttons/switches, handrails, shopping carts, check-out counters, restroom surfaces)
- Provide hand sanitizer for individuals at entrance and exit
- Face coverings not necessary for the general public
